Please provide an explanation for why so few site inspections were performed.***


Two "2" construction site plan/permit application reviews were completed for municipal sites, which are projects under construction by the Utilities Department. The number of construction site inspections for these municipal sites was also reported as "2" to represent the two (2) ongoing construction projects. In reality, daily construction site inspections are performed by City staff and our engineering consultants' construction inspectors throughout the duration of the projects.
