Please accept this letter in response to your comment dated May 11, 2010 with regards to the Town of Gulf Stream as follows:

Comment:

- 1) Section VII, Part III.A.9.b "Construction Site Runoff – Inspection and Enforcement"; The permittee reported "10" construction site plan/permit application reviews (private sites) and "5" construction site inspections (private sites). Please provide an explanation for why so few site inspections were performed.

Response:

*The Architectural Review and Planning Board reviews a number of submittal types which do not impact the site or stormwater runoff, such as the installation of impact windows, the addition of hurricane or decorative shutters or a sign review. These types of reviews would not warrant a site inspection. Two others were appeals to prior rulings of requests for demolition approvals but the projects had not gone to construction by the end of the reporting period.*
