**Please accept this letter in response to your comment dated May 11, 2010 with regards to the City of Riviera Beach as follows:**

**Comment:**

- 1) Section VII, Part III.A.1 "Structural Controls and Stormwater Collection Systems Operation": The Permittee reported "0" inspections of pollution control boxes. Please provide an explanation of why no inspections were performed.**

**Response:**

***We are using an intranet system that is fairly new to our department's system of record keeping. Some fields have been created to input new information, but it only comes as these items are introduced on a case by case basis.***

**Comment:**

- 2) **Section VII, Part III.A.8.a “Industrial and High-Risk Runoff – Identification of Priorities and Procedures for Inspections”:** The Permittee reported “7” new high risk facilities, “0” high risk facility inspections and comment “Inspect 08.” Please provide an explanation of why no inspections of the new high risk facilities were performed.

**Response:**

*The information for the cell in question was incorrect. There were no “New high risk facilities” reported. Therefore the “Number of Activities Performed” for high risk facilities should have had a value of “0”. “Documentation/Record” cell should have been blank.*
