Enclosed is the additional information requested as part of your review of the City of Boynton Beach's Year 5 Annual Report. We received the following comment:

City of Boynton Beach

- 1) Section VII, Part III.A.9.c Construction Site Runoff – Site Operator Training: The City reported “0” and commented “None notified” for the number of building permit applicants notified. However, the City also reported under Part III.A.9.a that “4” construction projects required an NOI. Please provide an explanation for why the City did not notify building permit applicants of their responsibilities under the State NPDES permitting program for construction site runoff.**

There is a typographical error in Section VII, Part III.A.9.c. The number of building permit applicants notified should be “4” with the comment “Projects are notified of NOI requirements during site plan review. Began Aug. 2007”. The City of Boynton Beach Engineering/Public Works Department revised their standard operating procedures for site plan reviews in August 2007 and began notifying applicants of the NOI requirements at that time. During the Year 5 reporting period through September 30, 2007, four (4) applicants were notified during site plan review as stated in Part III.A.9.a.
