Dear Ms. Jozwiak:

The following is in response to the comments concerning the Palm Beach County Municipal Separation Storm Sewer System (MS4), NPDES Permit No. FLS000018, specifically for the Town of South Palm Beach.

- 1) Section VII, Part III.A.7.d: The Town reported "0" for the number of activities performed for the spill prevention and response training reporting item. Provide an explanation of why no training occurred.

No spills occurred during this period. The only roadway in Town is A1A, which is under the control and jurisdiction of the Florida Department of Transportation. Any spills along this highway in the Town of South Palm Beach would be responded to by the Palm Beach County Fire Rescue, which has appropriate training. However, on March 19, 2008 the Town Manager as part of the NPDES Steering Committee attended training videos entitled "Ground Control for Construction Sites and Storm Warnings" obtained from Excal Visual. This training covered best management practices for soil erosion and environmental maintenance around municipal maintenance facilities.
