Enclosed is the additional information requested as part of your review of the City of Boynton Beach's Year 6 Annual Report. We received the following comment:

**City of Boynton Beach**

***1) Section VII, Part III.A.9.c "Construction Site Runoff – Site Operator Training": The City reported "0" and commented "None notified" for the number of building permit applicants notified. However, the City also reported under Part III.A.9.a that "6" construction projects required an NOI. Please provide an explanation for why the City did not notify building permit applicants of their responsibilities under the State NPDES stormwater permitting program for construction site runoff.***

As reported under Part III.A.9.a, the City of Boynton Beach notified "6" projects of the NOI requirements during the site plan review process for this reporting period. The correct number of building permit applicants notified is also "6" projects, as these are the same projects. This number was incorrectly reported as "0" in Part III.A.9.c. As part of our standard site plan review procedures, the City actively notifies applicants of their responsibilities under the State NPDES stormwater permitting program for construction site runoff. It should be noted that none of the "6" projects which were notified of the NOI requirements began construction during the reporting period due to current economic conditions.
