It was a pleasure to talk with you this morning to discuss the 'Comment' offered by DEP regarding the Town of Jupiter Inlet Colony 3rd Term, 1st Year Annual NPDES Report recently sent for review. There was some confusion on my part on how DEP wanted this budget information (Section IV, Fiscal Analysis of the Annual Report) addressed. I offer the following 'Response' to the 'Comment' based on our discussions this morning:

'Response' - The budgeted amounts to implement the Town's NPDES Stormwater Permitting Program actually 'increased' from the 2nd Term, 8th Year permit year (\$17,460) to that budgeted in the 3rd Term, 1st Year permit year (\$29,034) instead of decreasing (reductions) as implied by the

'Comment' - Expenditures increased substantially, however, due to the Town's participation in a new underground utility program.
